

ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING Tuesday, May 30, 2023

"Creating Strategic Alliances in Facilities Management"

1. Meeting Called to Order: Kelly Wilson

President Wilson called the meeting to order at 8:10 AM and greeted attendees. Called Secretary Adams to the podium.

2. Review & Approval of 2022 Annual Meeting Minutes: Greg Adams

Adams read the minutes into the record as written in Attachment 1. A call was made for edits or changes to the minutes from the floor. None were voiced. Adams turned the podium over to President Wilson for a vote to approve the minutes as read.

President called for a motion to approve. Motion to approve by David Van Hook. Art Frasier seconded. President called for vote. Motion carried.

3. Treasurer's Report: Bill Moody

Treasurer Moody stated the association is in excellent financial condition and reviewed financials provided in Attachment 2 for both accounts, GAPPA association and GAPPA Foundation. Noted that 2022 taxes are filed. Tax exempt status is in place for the next 3 years.

- 4. Committee Reports:
 - a. Workshop Committee: Tyler Alsen and Ed Dufresne

Tyler Alsen gave update on workshops planned for 2023-24. 1. Considering Georgia Power to talk about rate changes and their unregulated programs such as electric vehicle charging and solar generation. 2. Second workshop planned Jan/Feb. Several options are being considered. Alsen invites ideas from members for workshops.

b. Membership Committee: Dale Hess

Dale Hess reviewed the 3 categories of GAPA members and how many of each: institutional - 23, subscribing - 0, and business partner - 63. Gave costs for each. Please register online if not already.

c. Scholarship Committee: Katie Twining

Katie Twining reported that, since previous annual meeting, GAPPA reimbursed \$10,422.10 for scholarships. GAPPA is seeing a decrease in scholarship applications. Invited to the podium Todd Burman and Adam Strzemienski, who shared how they benefited from receiving scholarships. Katie reminded members that scholarships are available for APPA educational offerings and support for facilities management degree program expenses. Apply online with simple form.

d. Website: Sheree Srader / Laura Gay

5. Board Action to be Ratified by Members

President Wilson noted that, in 2022, the 2nd Vice President-Elect leadership GAPPA BOD position occupied by Katie Twining was vacated when Katie progressed to her current position of 2nd Vice President with no nominee brought forward at the 2022 annual conference to fill that vacancy. Rather than waiting until now to fill that seat and as provided in the GAPPA bylaws, the GAPPA Executive Committee moved as follows in August 2022:

The executive board recommends Daniel Warren, South Georgia College for the position of 2nd Vice President-elect.

The motion carried unanimously on August 3, 2022.

President Wilson called for a motion from the floor to ratify Danial's appointment to this seat by the Board. David Simms so moved. Seconded by Bill Moody. A call for discussion yielded none.

President Wilson called for vote on the motion: All of those in favor of ratifying Daniel Warren as the GAPPA 2nd Vice President-Elect, term expiring in 2024, indicate your approval by saying, yay. Opposed, nay. The motion carried.

Thank you, Daniel, for your willingness to serve.

6. Election of Board Members

President Wilson stated that, since the last GAPPA annual meeting, the Board received nominations for 3 open board seats, terms expiring in 2026. Those nominees were Ed Dufresne, FVSU, Russell Vullo, Mercer, and Dale Hess, UGA, Griffin Campus. The Board unanimously voted to fill the 3 open seats with these candidates on May 26, 2023.

a. Ratification of new Board Members

President Wilson called for a motion from the floor to ratify the Board's decision regarding the installation of these board members. A motion to ratify was made by Daniel Warren and seconded by Sheree Srader. A vote was called and the motion was carried unanimously.

7. Swearing in of new board officers and all board members

President Wilson called to the podium Rosalba Ledezma, SRAPPA President, to swear in the 2023 board members, which she did.

8. Joe White Award

President Wilson reviewed Joe Whites legacy and drew Savannah State University as the recipient of the \$1,000 award for 2023.

Joe White Award

Joe White began his career in higher education as the Resident Engineer Inspector for Macon Junior College in 1967. In 1968 he became the college's first Director of Plant Operations and he remained in that position until his retirement in 1997 from what had then become Macon State College. Mr. White became a charter member of GAPPA in 1982 and the first GAPPA Treasurer. He served in this office for over 20 years. As one of the founders of GAPPA, he was instrumental in building the organization into the vibrant developmental resource for educational facilities professionals in Georgia. Even after his retirement in 1997, both he and his wife Katherine continued to actively support the association to ensure its continuous growth and provide the critical training opportunities for its members.

In 1989, the GAPPA Board decided to honor Mr. White's long and valued service to the organization by providing The Joseph M. White Award – a \$1,000 grant presented to a Member Institution's Facilities Department to be used at the discretion of that department's management.

Mr. White passed away in May, 2010. He is missed and he will always be fondly remembered for his enormous contributions to GAPPA and its mission.
